

GARDENS AT QUAIL RUN

Plot Rules and Regulations

Gardeners agree to the following conditions and terms for garden plot use:

- Use the plot for growing food and/or ornamental plants during the current year's gardening season.
- Pay fees related to using a garden plot.
- Maintain the assigned garden plot and the surrounding gravel area. *Maintenance includes removing garbage, diseased plants, weeds, and unused vegetation.*
- Keep gardening area tidy, weed-free, and debris-free.
- Leave dogs outside the garden area. *Dogs are not allowed in the garden area unless they are service animals.*
- Help to keep the garden tool shed orderly and ready for all gardeners to use. *All garden tools and planting accessories should be stored in the shed, not in the garden area. Each tool and accessory placed in the tool shed must be labelled with the owners name or house number. Tools and/or accessories not marked will be disposed of after December 1st of each growing year.*
- Hoses used for watering that are not buried **must be** rolled up and placed where they will not interfere with those walking around the plots.
- Garden plots need to be cleared if the gardener moves away from Quail Run during the growing season. If another gardener takes responsibility for that plot, the office needs to be notified.
- Have garden plot prepared for winter by **December 1st**. *The plot is to be left weed-free.*
