

Sanipac Recycling Guidelines 2017

What can I recycle?

Only the following clean items are accepted in your blue 95 gallon commingle recycling cart:

Plastic – jugs, tubs and bottles only

Cardboard – flattened

Paper – newspapers, phonebooks, magazines, junk mail, computer paper and wrapping paper.

Metal – food and beverage containers. Clean aluminum foil in a ball no smaller than a baseball.

Only clean, unbroken glass bottles or jars are accepted in your blue 14 gallon glass recycle box.

What can be recycled in the Blue Box?

The 14 gallon blue box for glass recycling and is picked up on the same schedule as the commingled recycling.

What Can I Put In My Yard Debris Cart?

Your yard debris cart is for anything that grows above the ground. Examples include, plants, grass clippings, leaves, small branches (no larger than 4 inches in diameter) garden fruits and vegetables, bushes and flowers. Please do not put dirt, rocks, pet waste, plastic bags or poison oak in the cart.
