Quail Run Emergency/Earthquake Plan 2025

A. INDIVIDUALS: 7 Steps Immediately Following Disaster

- 1) Protect yourself and your loved ones. Drop, cover, and hold
- 2) Put on helmet, gloves, shoes. Check on household members. Administer care
- 3) Shut off gas at the gas main if you smell gas, see meter spinning, or hear hissing sound
- 4) Shut off water at the house main
- 5) Place the Help or OK sign in your front window
- 6) Put your fire extinguisher on the sidewalk for neighbors to use
- 7) After steps 1-6 are completed, go to the agreed upon gathering site for your courtyard

B. COURTYARD CAPTAINS: Assess Court Needs

- Look for HELP signs; check for injuries; give care as appropriate
- Check for gas leaks; turn off gas as necessary; shut off water
- Place laminated red/green (HELP/OK) sign on Courtyard house number sign
- Report Status to Team Leaders by text or FRS radio

C. DAMAGE ASSESSMENT TEAM (SAR) / CERT TRAINED: Report to Team Leader

- Deploy to affected courts, triage issues, develop plan of action
- Suppress fires, turn off gas and water if necessary
- Search lightly/moderately damaged homes
- Extract injured persons and administer primary first aid for airway obstruction, bleeding, shock
- Request additional medical assistance as needed
- Report status to Team Leaders

D. MEDICAL PERSONNEL: Report to Team Leader

Treat injured as appropriate and monitor status, and report back to Team Leader

E. TEAM LEADERS, DAMAGE ASSESSMENT TEAM/CERT, MEDICAL PERSONNEL, HOA PRESIDENT:

- Evaluate status of community and contact 911 or use GMRS radio for assistance as needed
- Plan next steps

F. HOA PRESIDENT AND BOARD: Organize Neighborhood Care Center

- Set up QR Clubhouse for use as a neighborhood care center
- Monitor by radio, FM/AM, NOAA, status of disaster situation
- Plan next steps with Team Leaders
